Senior Movies Synopsis of the Movies – January/February

Elvis & Nixon- "Elvis & Nixon" is about a very high profile meeting that once took place between Elvis Presley, the King, and President Richard Nixon. This meeting actually takes place in December of 1970 and came at the request of Elvis himself and what follows is essentially an unintentionally funny point in time where the two figures take a photograph that becomes iconic. In fact, the photo ends up being so iconic that it soon becomes one of the most sought after pictures in all of the National Archives.

Me Before You- "Me Before You" follows Louisa Clark (Emilia Clarke) as she begins a new job that involves caring for a quadriplegic, Will Trainer (Sam Claflin), with whom she begins to form a bond with. Once she discovers that Will is planning on committing assisted suicide in six months, she begins to create a schedule of activities and trips that they can take together in hopes of changing his mind on what he's capable of. As she works hard to reintroduce him to the world again, he also shows her a new side of life by pushing her to dream and enjoy a life that's bigger than their small town.

Now You See Me 2- When the Four Horsemen managed to stay out of jail by outmaneuvering the FBI, they became public heroes. The people looked at the Four Horsemen like they were the modern equivalent of Robin Hood. When it was over, each of the Four Horsemen vowed that they would never get involved in crime again. But when a shady tech entrepreneur surfaces to try and use the Four Horsemen to pull off one last heist, the group is forced to fight back to make sure the real story gets out. If the Horsemen do not clear their name, then this time they are going to jail.

Love & Friendship- After distasteful rumors about her social life circulate society at the tail end of the 18th century, Lady Susan seeks refuge at her family's estate. She decides to wait out the rumors in the company of her in-laws and her daughter. While waiting, she doesn't see any harm in trying to secure a husband for her daughter, even if her daughter has no interest in marriage. If Lady Susan has it her way though, they'll both be married once the rumors settle.

The Revenant- A team of fur trappers deals with the harsh wilderness in the Dakota Territory. Hugh Glass finds himself attacked and mauled by a bear. Instead of helping Glass, John Fitzgerald steals his equipment and leaves him for dead, believing that his injured friend has no chance of surviving. Glass manages to survive the mauling but then must face the wilderness on a journey for revenge. He faces countless obstacles and mounting grief in his attempt to find Fitzgerald.

Wild Oats- Eva is expecting a life insurance check in the realm of \$50,000. What she gets is one for \$5 million. With the error opening up a whole world of possibilities for her, Eva decides to take her best friend Maddie with her on the road for an adventure fueled by the unexpected windfall. Along the way the two become fugitives and find themselves the center of never ending media coverage.

Gleason- When diagnosed with ALS at 34, Steve Gleason could have put his entire life on hold. A former NFL defensive back and a hero to the people of New Orleans, Gleason didn't want to give up when he was told he only had a few years left to live. He decided to make the most of his life, spending his time with his family and friends and helping others afflicted with ALS, all while making a video diary for his newborn son.

The Legend of Tarzan- It has been a few years since Tarzan had dropped his life as an ape man and became completely immersed in London society. He has a prestigious job, and he has the respect of the people around him. One day, Tarzan gets word that a mining operation is preparing to set up very close to the part of the jungle that he used to call home.
