Call for Entries

Open to all artists 18 and over. You are invited to submit up to three digital images of your original artwork. Original works in oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel, charcoal, pencil, photography or a mixture of any of the above media are acceptable. Works previously exhibited in the Heartland Artist Exhibition are not eligible for entry.

Fees

The entry fee is a non-refundable \$45 for up to three entries.

How to Enter

A maximum of three digital images in jpeg format must be submitted to be juried. Images can be submitted on a disk, flashdrive or via dropbox with titles. Entries are accepted by mail, in person at the Tim Murphy Art Gallery, Irene B. French Community Center, 5701 Merriam Drive, Merriam, KS 66203 or completing an online application at www.merriam.org/heartland. Please include a self-addressed envelope if entry submission is to be returned.

Specifications and Presentation

Accepted artwork must closely represent the quality of the digital images in order to be included in the exhibition. All work must be matted, framed and wired for hanging; clip frames will not be accepted. Maximum size of the outside frame measurement is 40 horizontal by 40 vertical inches. The Tim Murphy Art Gallery is located inside the Irene B. French Community Center, please use discretion regarding subject matter (no nudes).

Judging

The decision of the juror on all entries is final. Exhibition selections will be made from digital images that must arrive with the entry form and fee at the Tim Murphy Art Gallery on or before January 15, 2020. Notice of acceptance will be made no later than January 24, 2020 via the website at www.merriam.org/park, along with a acceptance letter. Only juror selected works will be exhibited. The juror for this event is Nyle Gordon.

Final judging will be on site. If for some unforeseen reason the juror must withdraw before judging is completed, the Tim Murphy Art Gallery reserves the right to select another juror of similar rank to complete the juror's responsibilities. Artists will be duly notified in this event.

Sales

A 30% commission will be retained by the City of Merriam on all sales. All entries must be FOR SALE and remain for the duration of the exhibition at the Tim Murphy Art Gallery March 7-28, 2020. With the sale of any artwork, the artist will supply a completed W-9 before payment is made. Individual artist will be contacted directly, if this is needed. All sold work must remain in exhibition until conclusion of the show.

Delivery/Shipping and Receiving

- Art work must be received NO LATER THAN THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2020.
- Work must be picked up by Sunday, April 12.
- Artists are responsible for shipping and insurance cost to and from the venue.
- Provide prepared return mailing label and specific prepaid form to return art work (use forms provided by UPS and Fed Ex).
- Packages must be marked "FRAGILE" & PLEASE KEEP UPRIGHT-DO NOT LAY FLAT."
- Keep a copy of your return label with the tracking number; we cannot be responsible for tracking the return shipment. Do not forget to include prepaid return labels.

Artwork that is touched up prior to shipping must be completely dry prior to shipping. The artist agrees to authorize the City of Merriam, at its discretion, to utilize photographs of exhibited work for publicity purposes, not for reproduction.

Announcing 2020 Juror - Nyle Gordon

Born in Independence Missouri, Nyle Gordon was profoundly influenced by the people and environment of America's heartland. After graduating in 1984 from the University of Central Missouri, he embarked on a career in art exposing him to many disciplines. In 2004 Nyle left the corporate arena to pursue his first love of painting and returned to live near the family farm. Today, Nyle's time is divided between studio and outdoor plein air painting. Nyle is a representational painter who favors the strong use of shadow in his work. Structure and form are established early in the process and are intrinsic in clarifying a sense of space. There is a quality to Nyle's work that often elicits an impassioned response in the viewer.
