A few of our City Codes are important to keep in mind to maintain good neighborhood relations. Those codes are summarized below; please refer to the Merriam's Code of Ordinances for more information.

NUISANCES - SECTION 44-301 - PROHIBITED NOISE

- ▶ Producing excessively loud or annoying noise within the City is unlawful.
- ▶ Using sound devices to disrupt neighborhood peace is prohibited.
- ▶ Participating in gatherings that disturb residential peace isn't allowed.

TRASH CONTAINERS - SECTION 56-10 AND 56-13 SOLID WASTE CONTAINERS

- ▶ Containers must be stored out of public view, inside a structure, or behind the front building line.
- ▶ Containers can only be placed out for collection 18 hours before and after the collection time.

PARKING- SECTION 74-535 GENERAL PROVISIONS

No vehicles can be parked on the grass. Vehicles can only be parked on a hard surface.

SHORT-TERM RENTAL LICENSING SECTION 14-206 - LANDLORDS

Short-Term Rental operators must have a city-issued Short-Term Rental License and Residential Landlord License. The city conducts regular exterior inspections and biennial interior inspections of licensed properties.
